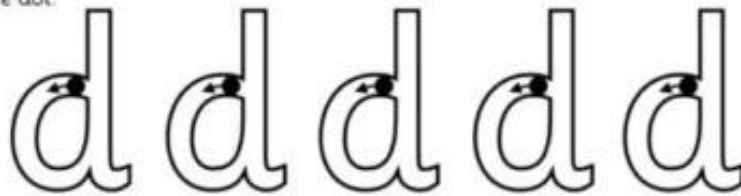

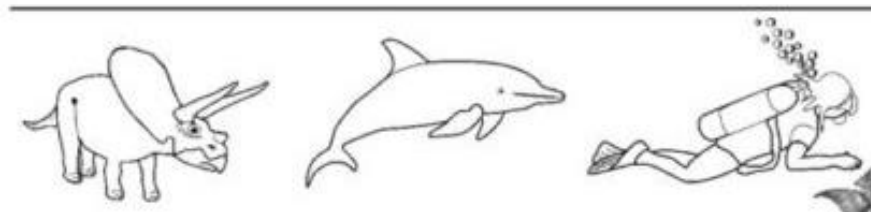
Phonics

Start at the dot.



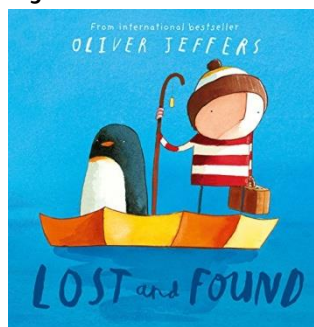
Now write d sounds along with line carefully with a pencil.



English

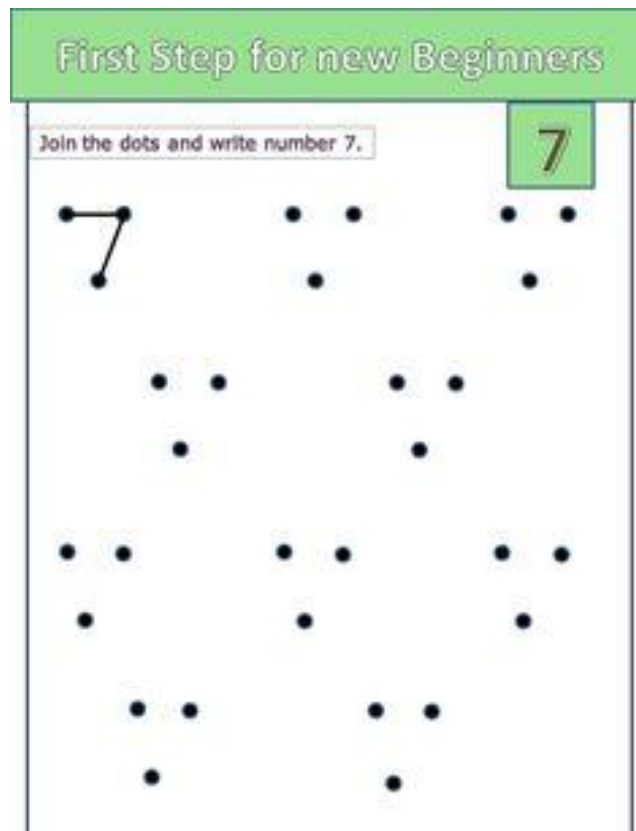
Thinking about our book for this week, Lost and Found, can you think of answers to the following questions:
