### Reception Work to support your child at home PHONICS

#### Work to support your child at home-LITERACY

#### Day 2-

Please draw some lines in your child's writing book and encourage them to sit their writing on the line.

Today's **writing** task:



Can you write our new sentences?

The words in green are tricky words and children are expected to spell these correctly. This week's sentences to learn are:

On Monday Mrs Grinling made some lunch and sent it to the lighthouse. The lunch was in the basket but the seagulls saw it and ate it all up.

Important note: Tricky word Mrs we have not formally learnt together yet, so grown-ups expect your child to need support with the spelling of this word.

#### Capital letters:

- Monday starts with a capital letter as it is a day of the week.
- Mrs Grinling starts with a capital letter as it is somebody's name.

## **Remember when writing:**

- Use your actions to help you know what word comes next. Use your sounds to spell the words. Remember: form letters correctly, capital letters, finger spaces and full stops.
- Adults <u>please remember to let the children use their own phonics knowledge, please do not spell the words for them</u>. Your role is to remind them about capital letters, to say their words slowly to hear each sound they need to write, finger spaces and full stops.
   You can support children with spelling the tricky words correctly if they need support.

## Reception Work to support your child at home MATHS - Money

Up to three people can play this game or just play it with your grown up. This is a money matching game, the first player to cover all the coins in the strip is the winner. Each have a strip with coins printed below. Cut out or use real coins which you used yesterday. Place them in a bag or purse.

Each player takes a turn to take out a coin from the purse/bag. Name the coin and if you have the picture of the coin place it on top. If you have already covered it then place the coin back in the purse/bag. The winner is the person who has covered all their coins first. Swap over coin strips and repeat.
