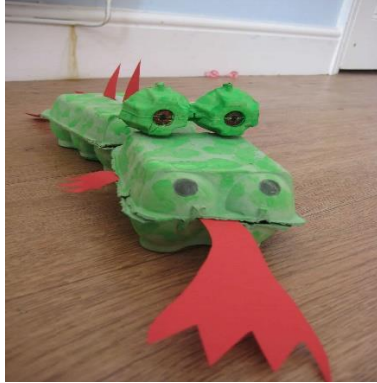

Today we are looking at action words and using the action words with the -ING sound on the end. The word with the first picture says walk, ask your child to tell you what the little girl is doing, can they say that she is walking? Try looking at all of the picture and using a sentence to describe each. For example, 'the girl is walking.' To extend this activity you can encourage the use of he and she, 'she is walking' and 'he is playing', these activities will really help your child to develop and extend their English vocabulary.
