Phonics

Today we would like you to practice writing all the sounds you have learnt this year! We can group them according to the writing pattern we use to help us write them (see Mrs Patton on Twitter to demonstrate this @devnursery)

Stir the pot letters: s a d g o c

Bouncy shape letters: p n m k

Long line letters: t i

English

Today we would like you to think about when questions. If you feel like a real challenge you could link this to time, but it's best to start simple with questions such as:

When do we eat breakfast?

When do you wear your pyjamas?

When do you brush your teeth?

You could even introduce a simple timetable showing what happens during the day, like the one we use in the nursery and then you can talk about after or before, for example...

What do we do after eating our dinner?


What do we do before we get into bed?

Being able to answer when questions and talk about time in such a simple way is very important and allows children to better understand routines, which will be very important when they go into Reception.




Maths
