This week is half term, so you get to have some fun. We thought as the weather is so nice and sunny and that you can get outside more, we have ten outside challenges especially for you!

- 1. Create an outdoor scavenger hunt where your collect items from nature. Count how many different items you can find. How many different colours can you collect?
- 2. Nature art collect leaves, flower, sticks and seeds to make natural artwork.
- 3. Go on a bug hunt! Take a photo of each bug you find. Ask you grown up if they know the name of it or do some research to name it.
- 4. Look for shapes in clouds. Set up a blanket and enjoy the sky!
- 5. Photo nature. Take pictures different types of birds which come into your garden. Draw a picture using the photo.
- 6. Water art. Take a bowl of water and a paint brush (if you haven't got a paint brush use a water bottle full of water) draw a picture see how long it takes to disappear.
- 7. Ride scooters, bikes or tricycles. Set up a mini race and compete on wheels.
- 8. Have a teddy bears picnic.
- 9. Make fairy soup. Collect leaves, petals, seeds and grass from outside and mix them together into a small bowl of water.
