## Maths

This week we are recapping all the numbers to 10 so today we would like to start with a 10 frame game. For this game you will need 2 10 frames, one for you and one for a grown up and 20 items you can place on them.

### How to Play

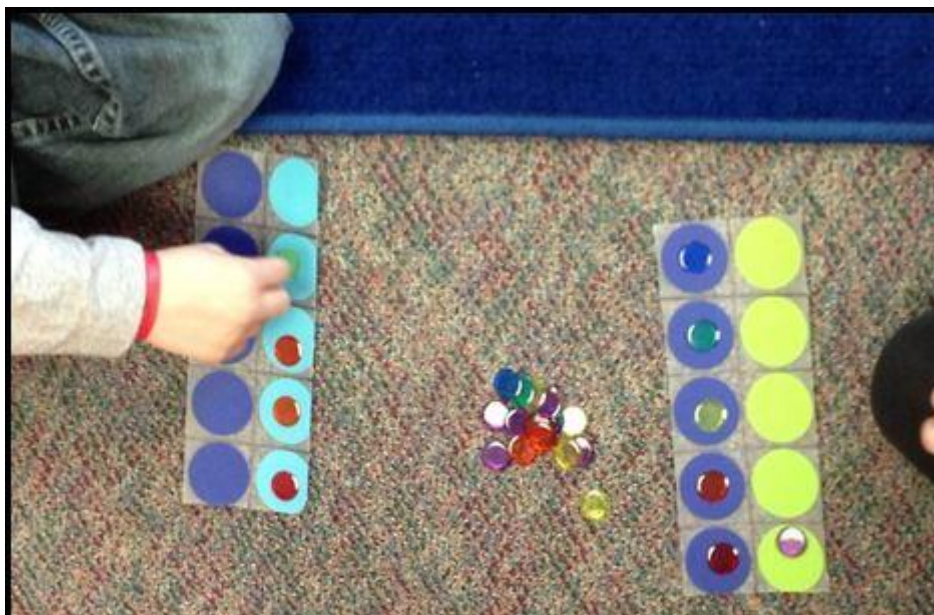
Grown ups start by putting an arrangement of items on their 10 frame and showing it (start off with a 3 or 5 second count) to your child before covering it up.

Children you then have to try and make the same arrangement on your 10 frame.

If your child struggles, show them again for a little longer until they can match the pattern. Then children you have to count and say how many counters are on your 10 frame.

Repeat and see how quickly the children can match your arrangement and always remember to count the number of items as this is all great practice of numbers 1-10.
