

Reception Work to support your child at home PHONICS

Below are some examples of how you can support your child at home with their phonics knowledge.

Children learn best with daily practise and by repeating the learning.

Day 3 –Read each sentence below, find the oi sound in each sentence and write the words with these sounds. How many words did you find? Can you write your own sentences using the same words.

Challenge yourself to think of some different words with this sound and have a go at writing them or clap them to your grown up.

For example – coin would be two claps for the sounds you say c oi n

- 3. Can you plant some seeds in the soil?
- 4. Is foil hard?

Read these sentences.

So **yesterday's example** sentences were:


